THE URIPOSTE JUKEBOX (A)

LAURA VAN DER HEIJDEN (B)

Since becoming BBC Young Musician of the Year in 2012, cellist Laura van der Heijden has gone on to establish a reputation as one of the most exciting cellists of her generation. In this concert she performs one of Bach's most loved solo suites for cello, together with works by Imogen Holst and Coleridge-Taylor Perkinson.


